Respected VCS Parents,

Valley Crescent administration has been closely monitoring the COVID-19 situation in Fresno County. The latest news that Fresno County has moved into Tier II (Red) in COVID case counts and positivity rate data, is a pivotal step toward the possibility of a safe return of our students to campus. Fresno County Schools can reopen for in-person instruction once the county has been in the red tier for two weeks. As indoor dining, theaters and other business sectors begin to re-open, VCS continues to effectuate plans to offer an in-person instructional option to our families along with a Distance Learning option.

Last Friday Sept 25th, VCS administration met with the school Board to discuss the process to open the school under an instructional waiver. In the meeting, it was concluded that we will be revisiting and updating the Guidelines and plans established in summer for the possibility of safely reopening the school. These plans will continue to move forward and include bringing our students whose families choose an in-person option back on campuses in a hybrid instructional model for the 2nd trimester (Mid November).

The timeline allows parents and staff to have a voice in the practical implementation of health and safety guidelines. Families will also be provided with the opportunity to revisit earlier choices about online, and possible in-person instruction. Detailed plans will be released at the end of October, *Insha Allah*
